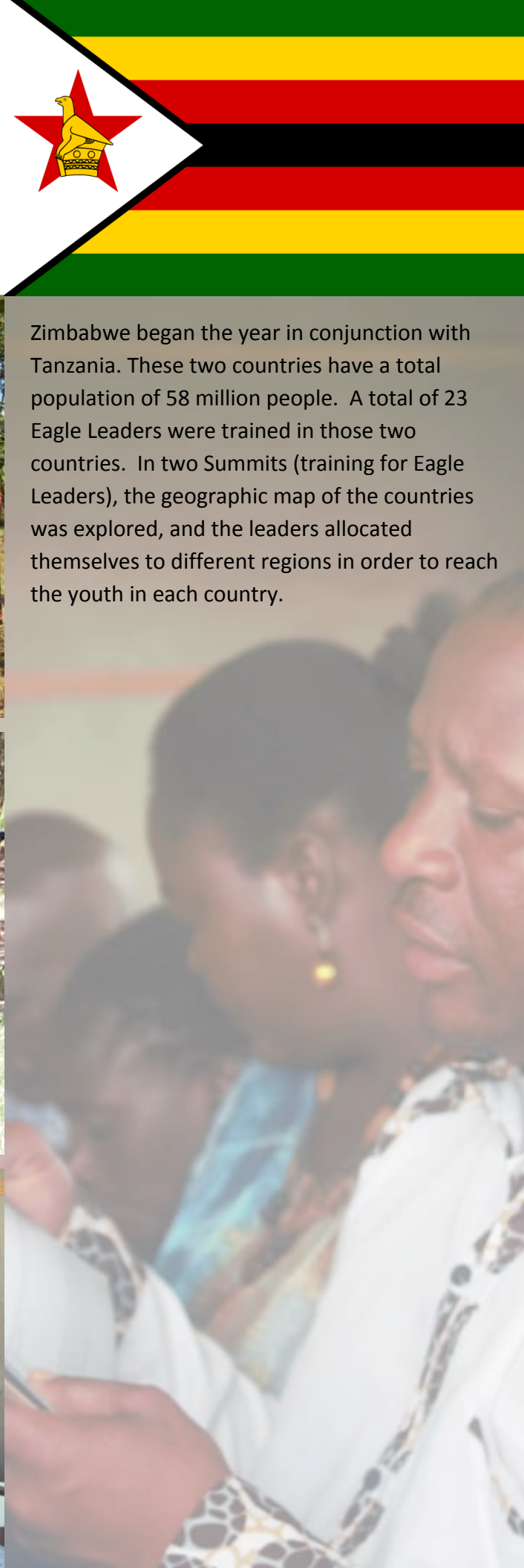
An update

ZIMBABWE

Country Leader Reuben Zivagwe



Zimbabwe began the year in conjunction with Tanzania. These two countries have a total population of 58 million people. A total of 23 Eagle Leaders were trained in those two countries. In two Summits (training for Eagle Leaders), the geographic map of the countries was explored, and the leaders allocated themselves to different regions in order to reach the youth in each country.



Then, in February, Zimbabwe hosted both an Eagle Summit as well as a Forum. During the Harare Summit, 11 Eagle Leaders from Zimbabwe were trained with the new approach: Jesus-Focused Youth Ministry. JFYM Botswana Country Leader, Lawrence Kairuki Kinuthia, led this meeting. With a Zimbabwe map spread, leaders allocated their ministry reach to different areas in order to have the greatest impact on the youth. The population of Zimbabwe is about 15 million people.

Immediately following the Summit, a Forum was hosted. 52 leaders from seven denominations attended. They gave testimony of how hundreds of youth have been reached with the gospel.



Reuben, our Country Leader, has a budget for three Forums for the next three months. He is expecting 50 leaders each meeting. Recently, he has disciplined youth from his home. We are excited to see the fruit of his most recent efforts!
