Pray for Africa

Our African Country Leaders are facing the challenge of caring for their families, congregations, and communities during the pandemic. Each country is not only dealing with the fear of the virus itself, but also the devastating effects of economic shutdown.

Obadiah: Our interim Africa leader said that people in his village in rural Kenya will soon die of hunger if the circumstances do not change. Many find it challenging to even find water because of the current drought.

Enoch: He and his wife are caring for 15 children who are all currently living under their roof. Supplies are running low, and they have asked for our prayers.

Christopher: He and his wife are physically separated because of the lockdown in Nairobi. His wife and three of their children were out of town visiting relatives when the lock down started. She is now unable to join her husband in their home. The location where she and the kids have been residing is now running out of food.
